

GERMAN 30 COURSE TOPICS

1. Interests:

describing what one watches on TV and other interests, and describing what one will do in the future.

2. Culture and Cuisine:

describing what cultural events one can attend, different types of cuisine, and being in a restaurant.

3. Appearance:

asking for and expressing opinions with regards to one's appearance, expressing sympathy, giving advice and reasons, admitting to something and expressing regret.

4. Relationships:

describing one's relationship to others and hypothesizing.

5. Rights and Responsibilities:

describing what one could do, what one would have liked to do and what one is doing right now, and reporting past events.

6. The Media:

describing how one gets their information and continuing how to report past events.

7. Advertising:

describing how one is influenced through advertising.

8. Stereotypes and Prejudices:

describing German and Canadian stereotypes.

9. The Environment:

describing problems and solutions with the environment.
