The Farm is an alternative high school program where students learn in a variety of ways to become engaged in what they are learning. Highly passionate and thoughtful teachers create learning experiences that cover the curriculum through the lens of growing the food the world eats. Other opportunities offered from the community allows students to better understand how Agriculture plays an important part in our world

How do we enrich a student's learning?

- * Run a chicken and egg operation

How long does the program run?

This program runs for the entire year September to June.

What courses and credits are offered?

Students can earn credits in Entrepreneurship, Construction, Agriculture, Mechanics, Communication, Finance, Marketing and Design. Students also work with teachers to earn credits in areas of passion and interest (for example a student earning credits in photography and web design because it is something they started before the school year).

Students also cover all the curriculum in English, Social Studies, Math, Science, Physical Education and CALM
