

Rocky View Schools (RVS) is committed to the health and safety of students and staff. With visitor restrictions in place in RVS schools, we're continuing our contactless and cashless fee payment and introducing contactless permission forms.

School Fees

Parents are asked to use their School Cash Online account to pay all school fees (schools will no longer be able to accept cash or cheques sent in with students). Paying online also supports quicker refunds compared to manual/cash payments.

When fees are added, you'll receive an email notifying you that you can log in to School Cash Online to make payment. The School Cash Online platform accepts credit cards (Visa and MasterCard), e-cheque and debit card (through the e-wallet function).

RVS students can also have their own School Cash Online account. If they are responsible for paying their own fees, they can log in and make a payment with their debit or credit card, just as parents would.


Permission Forms

Many of RVS' clubs and extra-curricular activities require parental authorization. Parents are now able to approve their child's attendance to an activity or event online instead of sending back paper forms.

Parents choosing this option will receive an email notifying them that an activity requires approval. Once logged into School Cash Online, parents can input any required form information and sign electronically. If the item has a fee associated with participation parents can pay at the same time.

Fundraising and Donations

All fundraising and donation opportunities will be posted to School Cash Online or through a verified third-party online application. As all payments can be processed online, students no longer need to bring cash or cheques to school and won't miss any important opportunities to contribute to a worthy cause.
