

Bert Church High School: Career Advantage Program (CAP) Health Sciences

The Career Advantage Program (CAP) is an initiative designed by and delivered in Bert Church High School to empower students in pursuing careers in targeted fields. Health Sciences CAP Grade 10 students will take 2 classes in each semester as a part of the cohort; the remainder of their courses will fulfill their other grade 10 requirements, as well as one additional option. As a member of this CAP, students will get an intensive look at biology, body systems, human health and physical activity.

Benefits:

- Students will be immersed in Health Sciences
 - Opportunity to explore career options and enrich their learning
 - Targeted support of their learning plan to pursue post-secondary
 - Accelerated high school programming, including a grade 11 science
 - Receive Standard First Aid, CPR Level C and AED training

Requirements:

- Students must be eligible to take Science 10 and Math 10-C (60% or higher in Science and Math 9)
- Complete online application by 12:00pm April 20, 2020

Proposed Courses for the School Year:

- Semester 1
 - Science 10
 - Sports Medicine 10
 - CALM 20 (online) with support in Flex
- Semester 2
 - Biology 20
 - CTS courses on the cardiovascular, digestive, respiratory, and urinary systems
 - Physical Education 10
 - Sports Performance 10
- Math, English, Social Studies and one additional elective to be scheduled outside of the cohort according to student requirements
